## Moniteau Jr/Sr High School Levels of Consequences for Progressive Discipline

The table below categorizes examples of misconduct into levels of severity, and identifies corresponding consequences for each level. It is understood that not all possible infractions are specifically listed. The principal or designee reserves the right to make decisions on disciplinary action based on the severity of the offense and each individual situation that arises.
