<u>Tana (Willetts) Frangioni Memorial Scholarship</u> is awarded to one senior boy and one senior girl who exhibit the traits and qualities of Tana. Her mantra was "Make Good Choices" and she lived by this everyday. The candidate should be a two sport athlete, a good student, a good friend & a good person.

<u>Darrion Rock Memorial Scholarship</u> applicants must be decathlon students who are interested in attending post secondary school for History or Teaching.

<u>Ashley Hasychak Memorial Scholarship</u> requires qualified applicants to be on the track and field team and have a minimum GPA of 3.0. **Letters of recommendation** must be from someone other than your track or field coach.

Robert J. Thompson Family Scholarship requires students to be entering an accredited RN program of study or a medical field for post secondary schooling.

<u>Michelle Yeager Krill Memorial Scholarship</u> Is awarded to a senior female basketball player that embodies dependability, a strong work ethic and leadership qualities. They do not have to be attending a 4 year college. It can be any type of trade as well.

Art and Ethel Eshenbaugh Scholarship requires applicants to be majoring in the education or nursing fields.

Robert and Donna Young Memorial Scholarship applicants must have a 2.5 GPA.

<u>Jeff and Laura Campbell Scholarship</u> winners are selected based on: GPA, Attendance, Disciplinary Record, and Enrollment in a college (majoring in education or environmental engineering) or a trade school (HVAC or electrical).

<u>Brian and Kevin Thomas Memorial Scholarship</u> requires applicants to participate in a varsity sport and an academic competition during their senior year of high school. Preference is given to Decathlon students. Applicants must acquire a letter of recommendation from their coach and their Decathlon advisor (if applicable).

<u>DiBiase Award</u> is for a student enrolled in a 4 year institution to pursue an engineering degree or a music degree. Applicants must have a 3.5 GPA or higher and be an active member on student council, in their church, in their community, or all three.

<u>Michele Matz McCracken Endowment Fund</u> is for a female track athlete recommended by the track coach. A thank you note is required to receive the funding of this scholarship.

<u>Davidson Family Scholarship</u> is awarded to two graduating Moniteau seniors who complete the application and are chosen by the scholarship committee.

<u>Wm F and Cora Young Scholarship</u> shall be awarded annually to a Moniteau Jr Sr High School student that participated in band or choir (or both) for 2 or more years and will be pursuing a career in the field of science or the field of medicine.

<u>Jay E Hewitt First Generation Award</u> will be given to a senior attending a 4 year college or university who will be a first generation college student or intends to pursue a career in a helping profession (psychological counseling, social services, education, or health related field). Participation in extracurricular, church, or community activities required.

Robert McCarl Memorial Scholarship will award two scholarships. One scholarship will be awarded to a senior on the football team and one will be awarded to a senior on the basketball team. Letter of recommendation from Moniteau High School faculty required.

Olivia Bartholomew Memorial Scholarship winners are selected by the scholarship committee.

<u>Kristufek Family Scholarships</u> - 2 scholarships will be awarded, one in a STEM field and one in a Computer Science field. Applicants must have a GPA of 3.2 or higher, and submit an essay on why you chose your intended field of study. Essay should be 400- 500 words in length.
