Dear Students and Parents:

The Butler Area Vocational Technical School **will not be in session** on the following dates but the Moniteau School District **will be in session** on:

**December 22, 2022, January 13, 2023, February 17, 2023 March 17, 2023, April 11, 2023
May 12, 2023**

Students may ride the bus to school as they regularly do. For the time that they would be at Vo-Tech (7:25am - 10:30am), the students will be placed in study halls. Students do have the option to drive to school on these days (must have a Moniteau Parking Permit) or be dropped off at the school. If your student chooses to drive or to be dropped off on these days, **THEY MUST BE IN THE SCHOOL AND SIGNED INTO THE OFFICE NO LATER THAN 10:39 AM OR THEY WILL BE CONSIDERED LATE FOR THE DAY.**

On the following dates, the Butler Area Vocational Technical School **will be in session**, however the Moniteau School District **will not be in session**. The district will provide transportation from the high school to Vo-Tech and then back to the high school on the following dates:

November 10, 2022, February 10, 2023, June 1, 2023, June 2, 2023, June 5, 2023 and June 6, 2023

If you are planning to drive to Vo-Tech on the above dates, the student must have a Moniteau Parking Pass and a Vo-Tech Parking Pass. The Vo-Tech Parking Pass Application can be obtained at the Vo-Tech or at www.butlertec.us. A copy must be kept on file in the High School Office.

★ Just so you are all aware, students will need to be brought to the high school by 7:15am to catch the bus to Vo-Tech. **The bus will leave promptly at 7:25 am. The vo-tech bus will arrive back to the high school at 10:30 am. Students must be picked up at the high school at 10:30 am. There is no bus transportation home on these days.** Students will not be permitted to enter the building on these days.
