Koi Fish Aquaponics Pond:

The Koi Pond is progressing nicely. The pond liner, gravel for the base, and a mixture of potting soil, top soil, and garden soil was added. The water was pumped in, and it actually works! The garden filters water and does not back up, or flood the growing area. Artificial lighting was added to promote growth. Students planted radishes, carrots, and onions to start the growing process. The next step is to get the Koi and make a complete system.














Animals Systems Skeleton Project

Students in the Animal System class are studying skeletal systems, as a class project they chose an animal and created a skeleton out of paper and masking tape. They had to make it as realistic as possible and label 25 of the individual bones.
